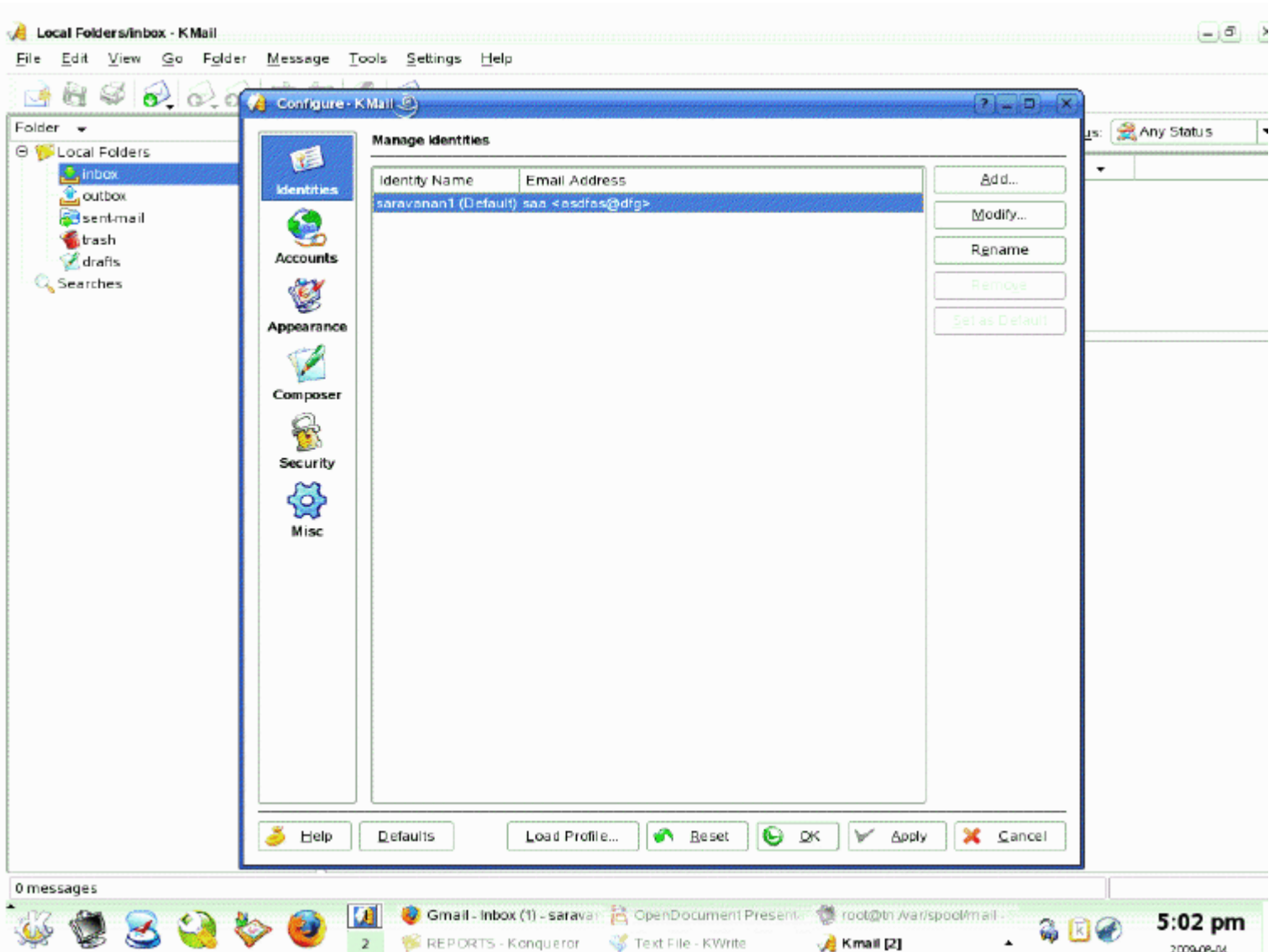


Click K Menu → select Internet → click E-mail → select K Mail in the Menu Bar

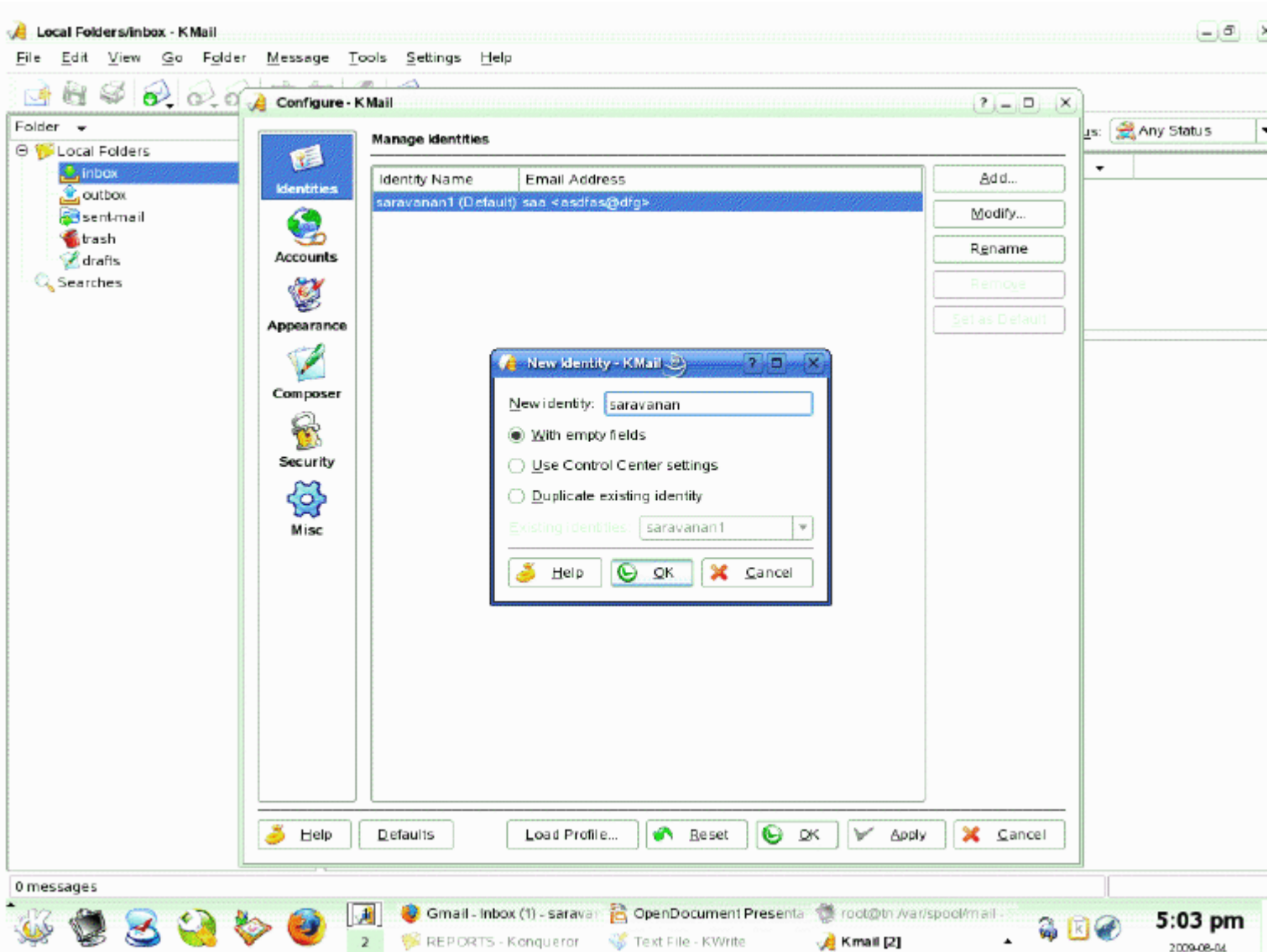
Then the K Mail program will be opened

Then go and select **settings menu** and click **configure k mail**

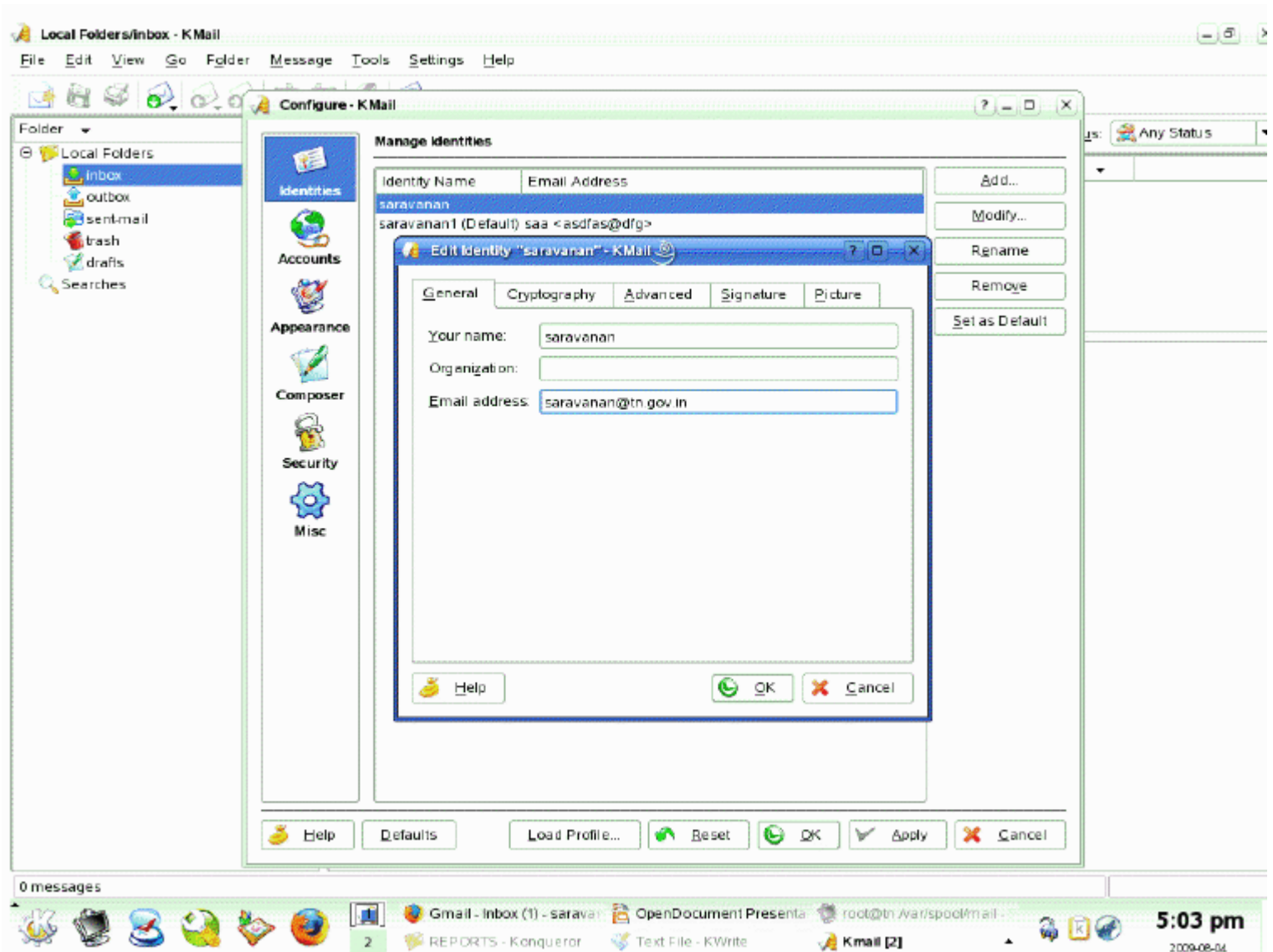
Then it will show like this picture



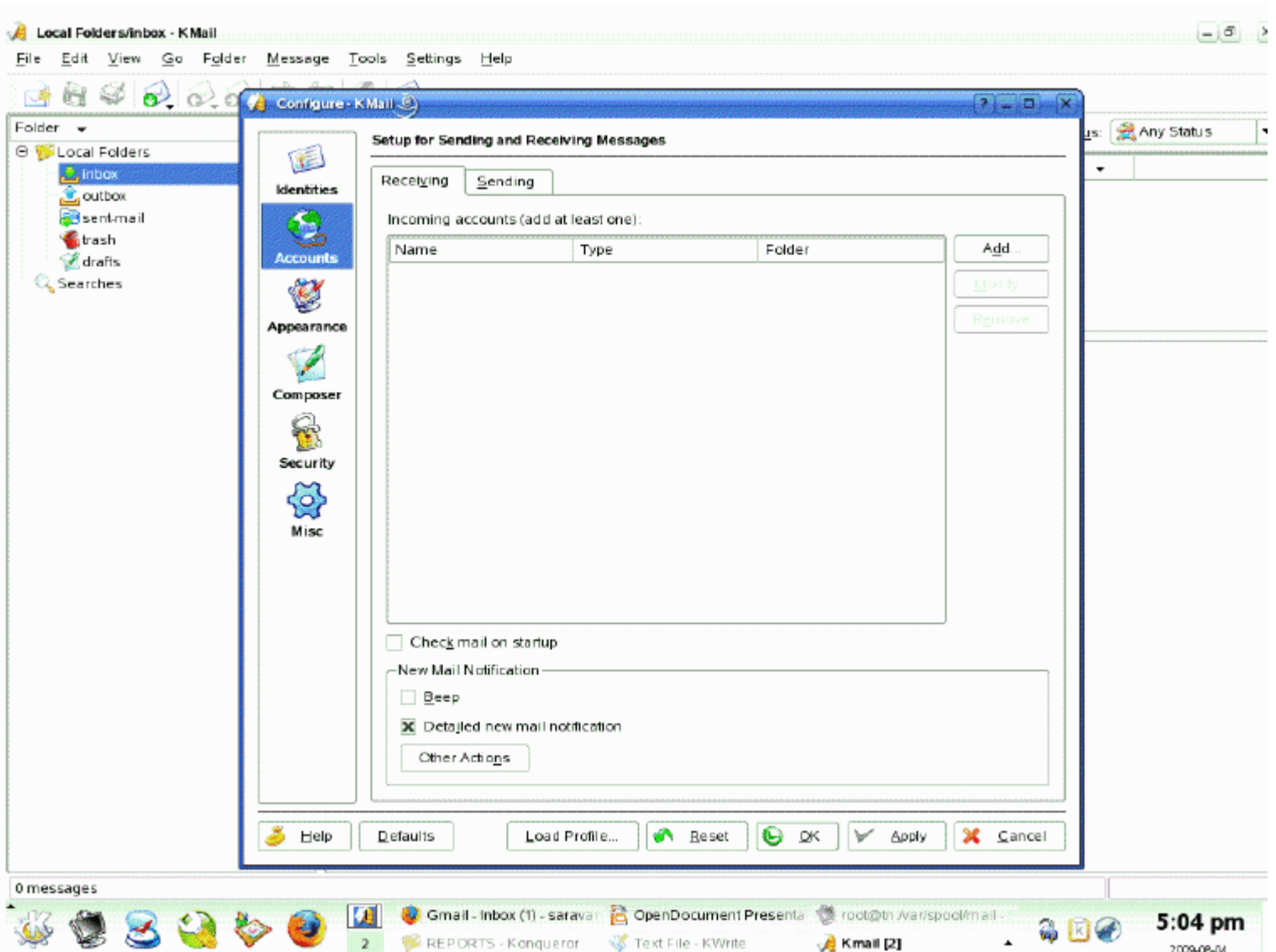
In configure k mail menu **select Identities** and **click add**  
It will show another dialog box in that box you have to enter **your account name** and click ok



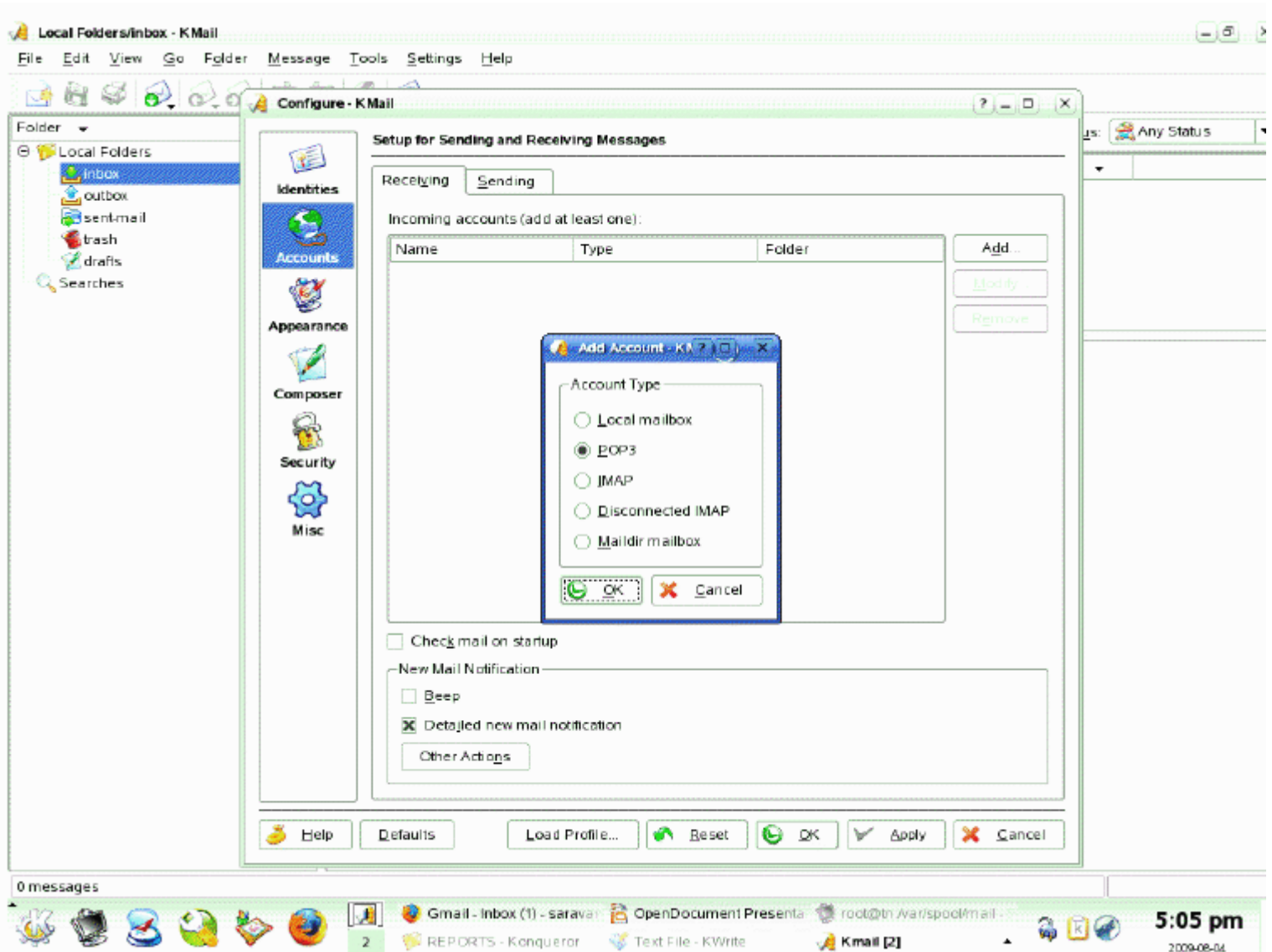
Then it will show another dialog box in that box you have to enter **your name** and **e-mail address** in that bar then click ok



Then click **accounts** in the dialog box

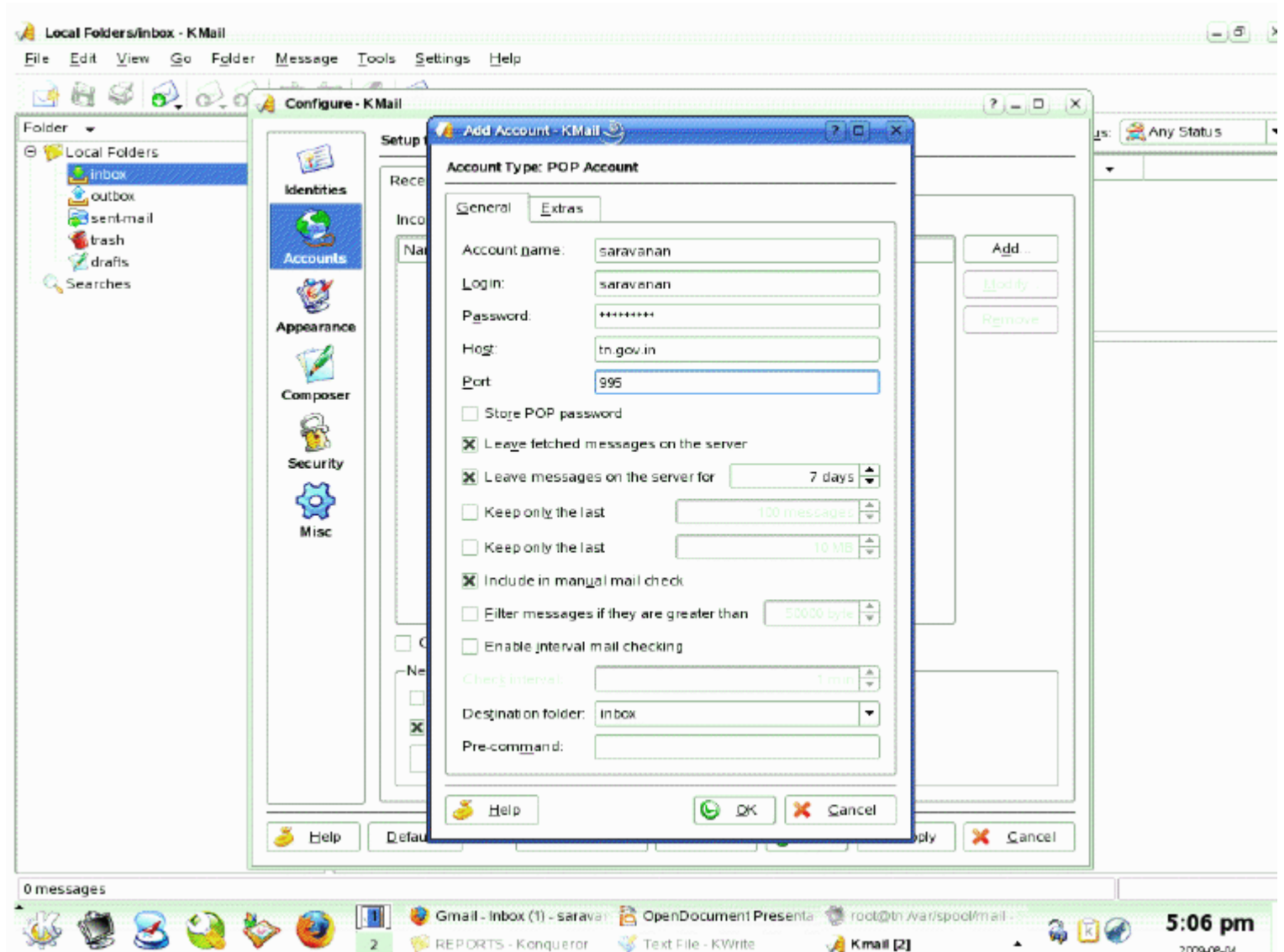


Then click add button in that box it will show another dialog box in that we have to select **POP3** and click ok



## Then we have to enter the account information

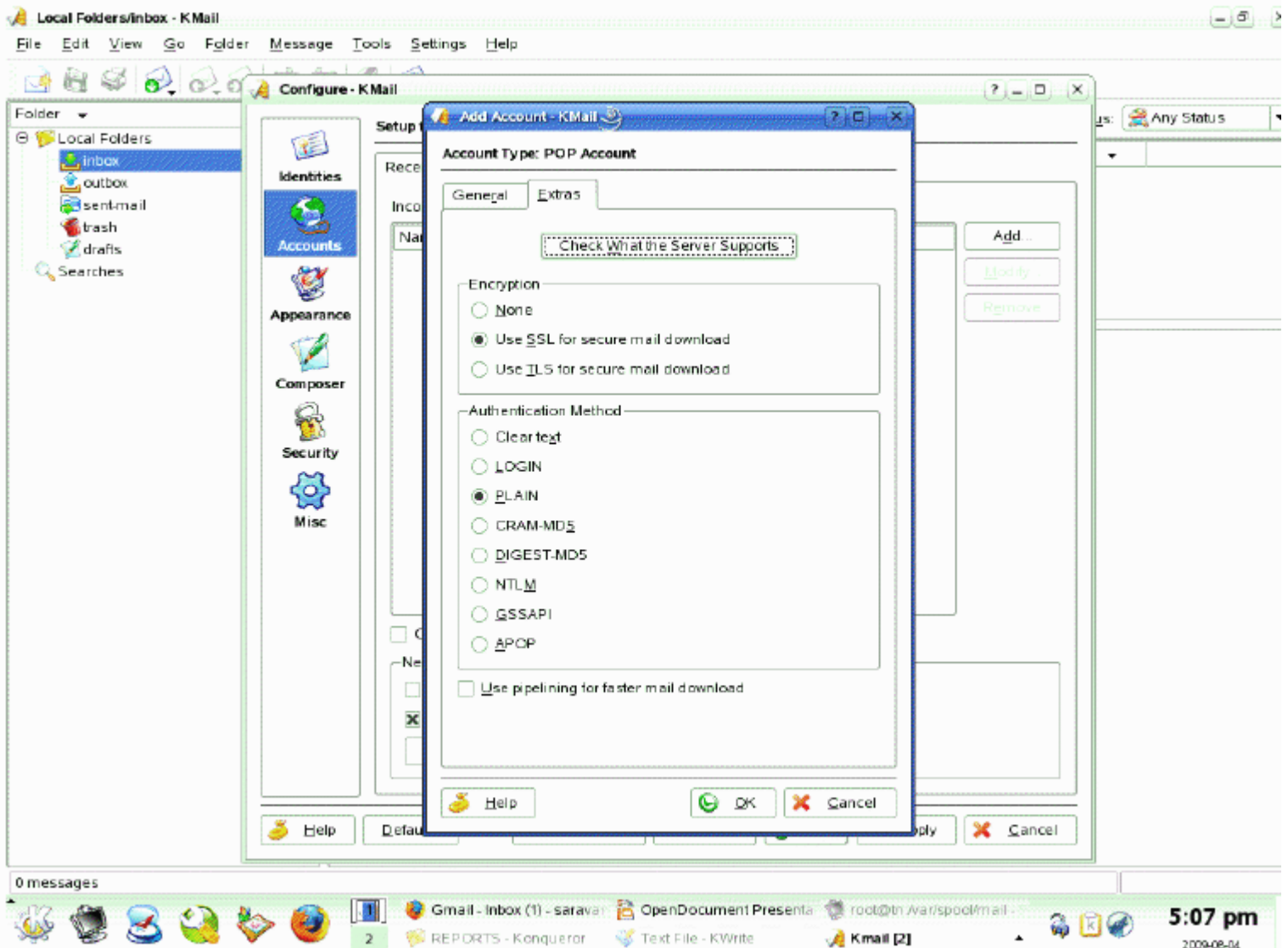
1. Give your **account name**

Then click Extras

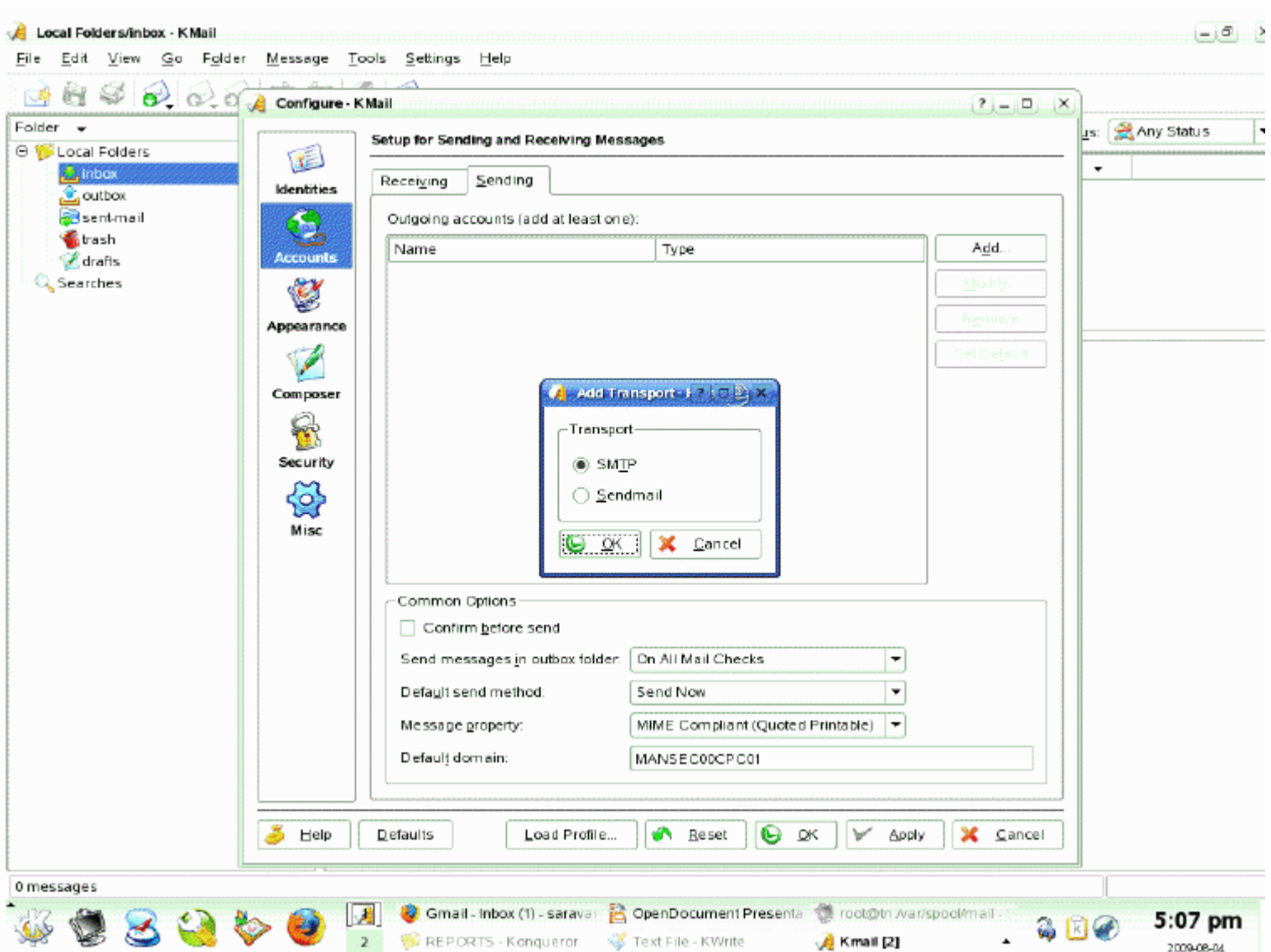
In that dialog box

In accounts dialog box select **sending** and click **add**

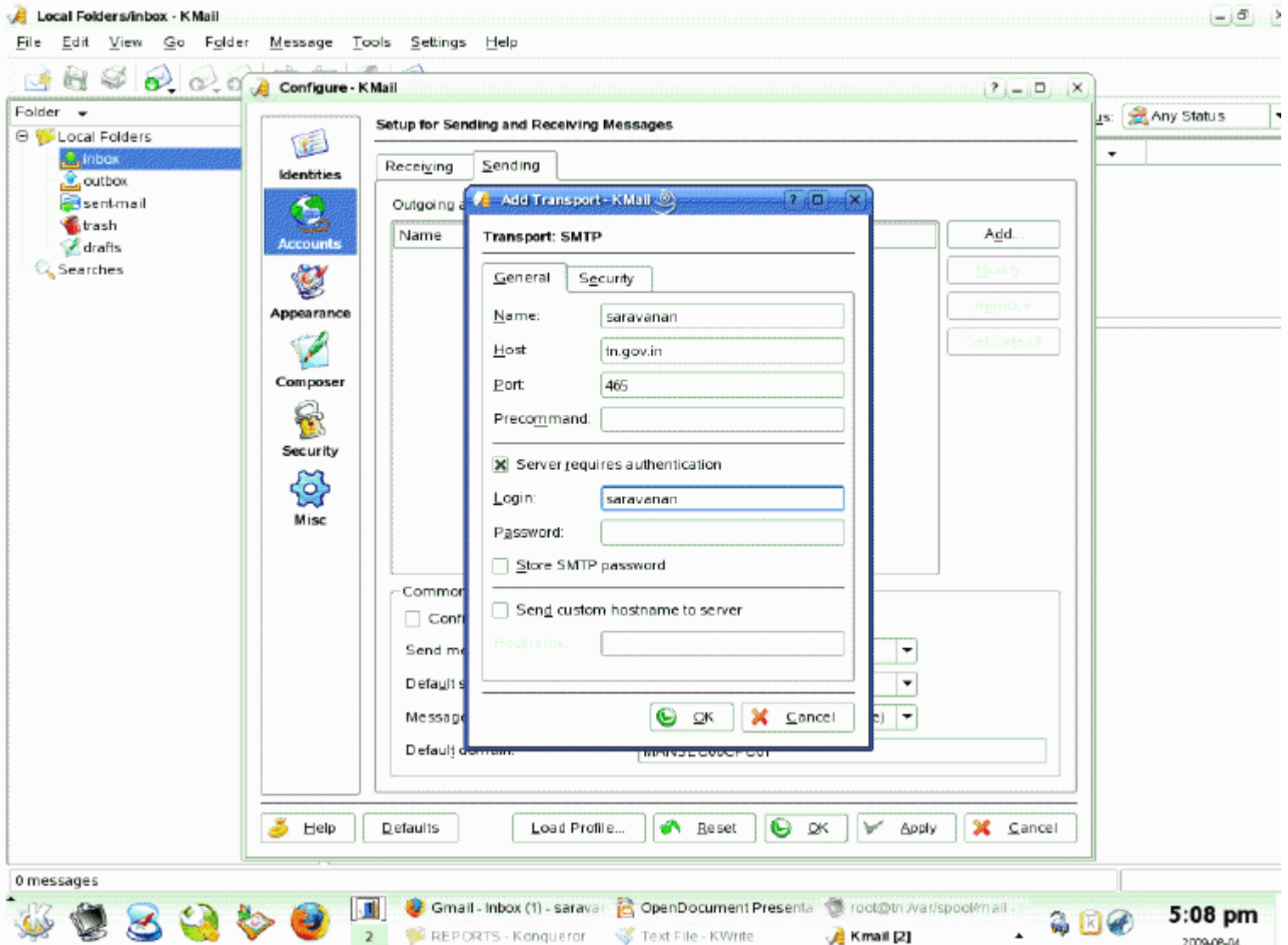
Then it will show another dialog box in that box select **SMTP** option click ok





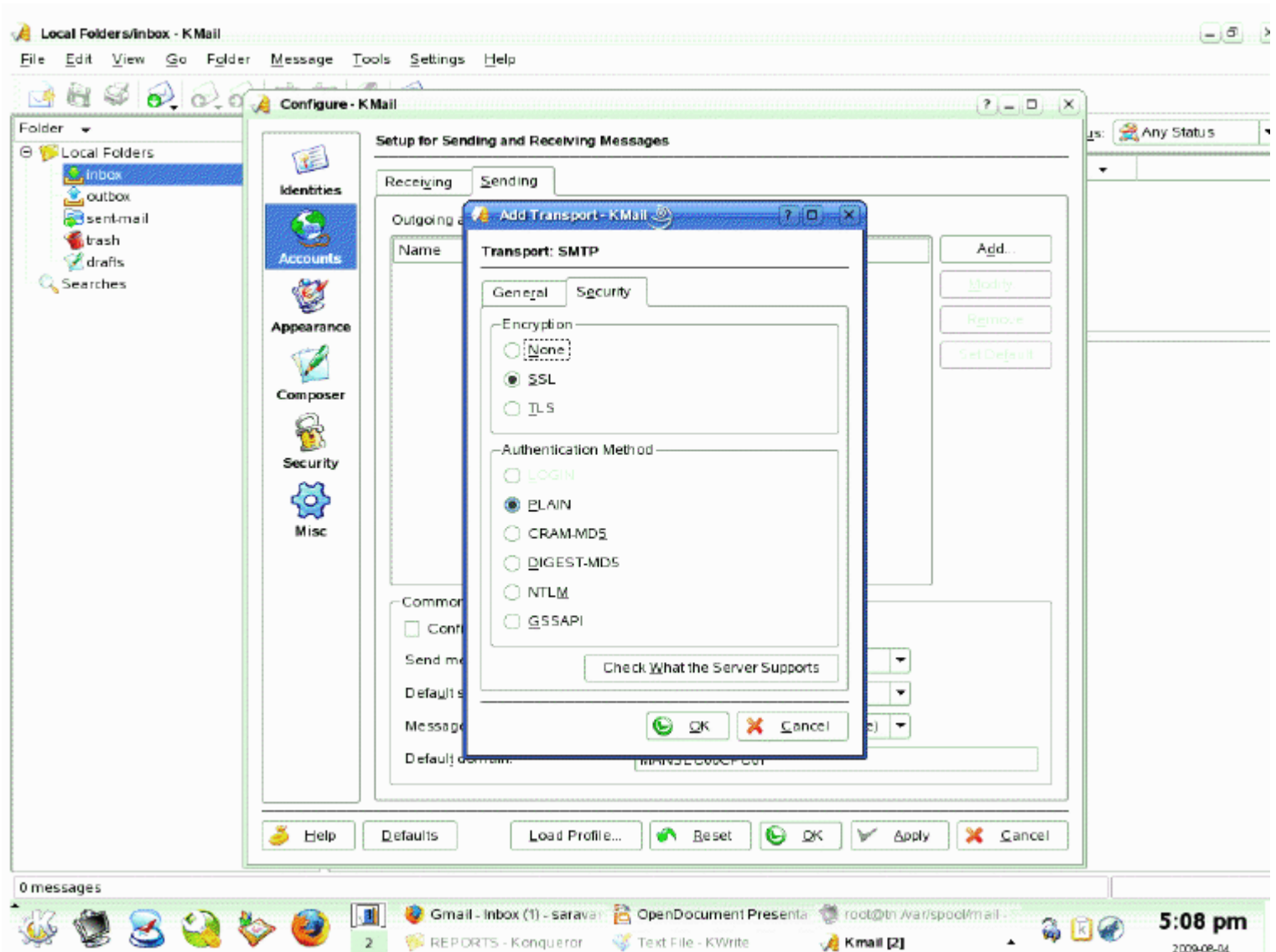
Then it will shown another box in that box select **general**

6. Then click security option

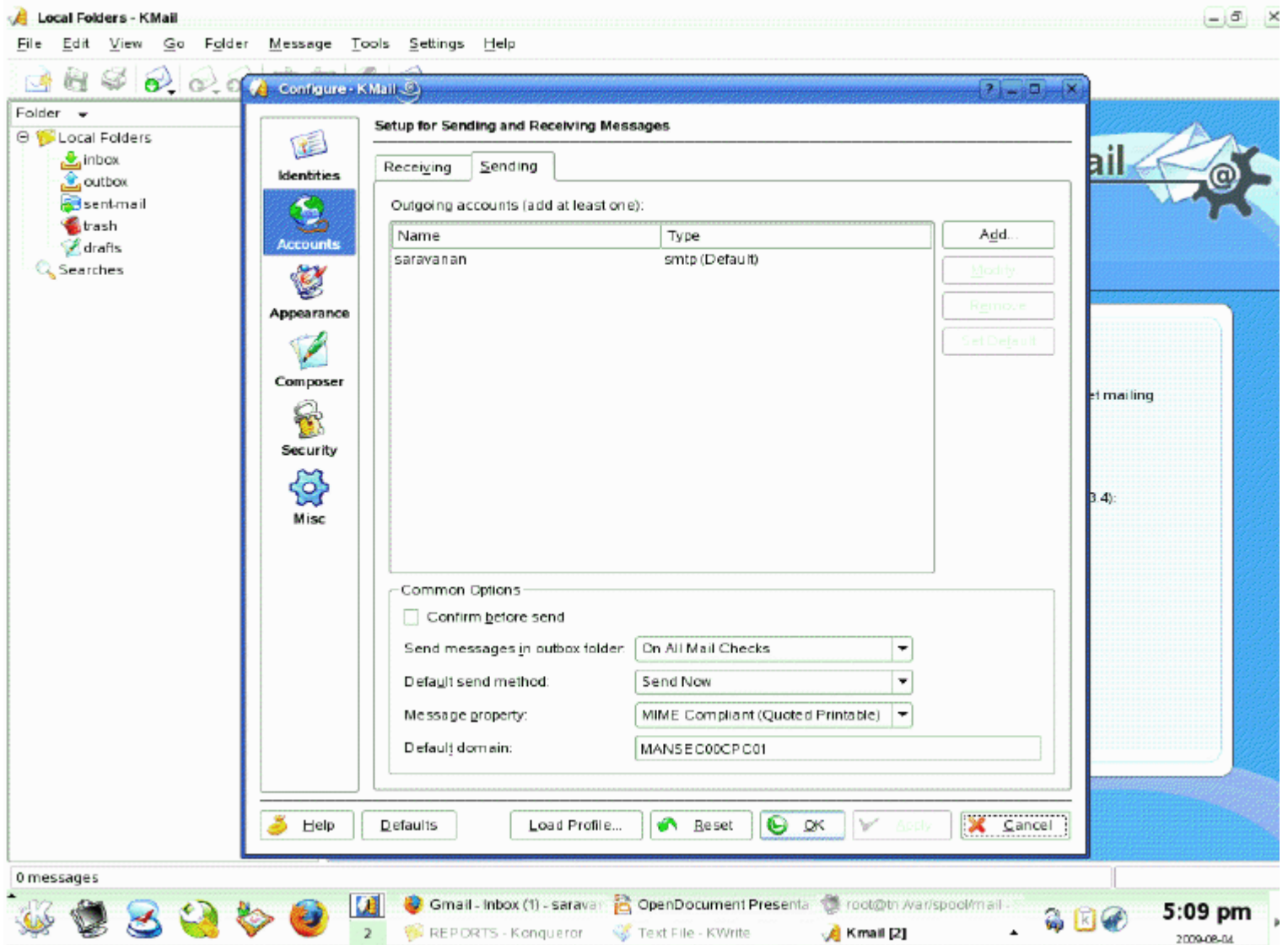


In security box select **SSL** option
